• While Democrats back Biden's policies of open borders and broken immigration; Republicans want to secure the border and stop the flow of deadly fentanyl.

Biden and Democrats Have Created the Worst Border Crisis in American History

In the last 2 years, there have been over 4.1 million illegal border crossings – the most in U.S. history.

- In Biden's first 100 days in office, he took 94 executive actions on immigration, including:
 » Stopping construction of the border wall, halting deportations; and suspending "Remain in Mexico."
- At every turn, Senate Democrats voted in lockstep for Joe Biden's disastrous border policies.
 - » In 2021, when Democrats passed their reckless \$1.9 trillion spending spree:
 - $\cdot\;$ They voted to end the Remain in Mexico program; and
 - · They voted to send checks to illegal immigrants and fund sanctuary cities.
 - » In May of 2022, Democrats voted to expand Biden's policy of catch-and-release.
 - Earlier this year, Biden's DHS issued a rule to give USCIS the authority to grant illegal immigrants' asylum without requiring those individuals to have a hearing before an immigration judge.
 - Democrats voted with Biden, and against a Republican CRA that would have rescinded this rule.
 - » In August 2022, when Democrats passed their latest reckless spending bill.
 - Democrats voted <u>for</u>:
 - Funding hiring 87,000 new IRS agents *instead of* hiring more border patrol agents.
 - · Democrats voted **against**:
 - Funding border security and border agents.
 - Ensuring Immigrations and Customs Enforcement had sufficient resources.
 - Providing funding to implement Title 42.
 - Funding the border wall; and
 - Improving screening and detection of narcotics like fentanyl at the border.

• The result: Democrats have created the worst border crisis in American history.

» In the last two years, Customs & Border Protection encountered over 4.1 million illegal crossings at the U.S. Southern border -- setting new historic records for illegal crossings in FY2O21 and FY2O22.

• As the border crisis has grown, so too has the amount of fentanyl flooding into the U.S.

- » Over the last two years, drug overdose deaths largely driven by fentanyl have become the leading cause of death for adults 18-45-years-old.
- » In the last two years, seizures of fentanyl at the Southern border have hit record highs.
 - · In 2022 alone, over 14,000 pounds of fentanyl was seized at the border a new record high.
 - Over 14,000 pounds of fentanyl is enough to kill the entire U.S. population 9 times.
- » Record-high fentanyl seizures only tell half the story.
 - Fentanyl seizures account only for the fentanyl that Border agents are able to successfully detect.
- » Even as CBP seizes fentanyl, cartels continue to successfully smuggle fentanyl into the interior of the U.S.
 - In 2021: Despite CBP reporting record fentanyl seizures, <u>DEA reported</u> seizing in the interior of the United States over 15,000 pounds of substances containing fentanyl and over 20 million fentanyllaced prescription pills.
 - <u>In 2022</u>: Even though 12,300 pounds of fentanyl has been seized at the border, <u>DEA has recovered</u> 20,000 pounds of fentanyl in the interior.

Republicans want to secure the border and stopthe flow of deadly fentanyl.

- That means:
 - 1. Ensure our immigration laws are enforced.
 - 2. Bring back the Remain in Mexico program.
 - 3. Finish building the wall.
 - 4. End the incentives that are feeding the crisis.
